

# Family Chore Wheel

A chore wheel is a great way to get the whole family involved in doing the household chores fairly. It can help you avoid all those squabbles about who does what, and when!

It comprises of 2 wheels, secured together at the centre with a split pin, as shown below. The family's names are written around the outside edge of the large pink wheel.

A different family chore is written in each section of the smaller green wheel.

The two wheels are then joined together at the centre point, with a split pin. The green wheel should be placed on top of the pink one and should spin freely.

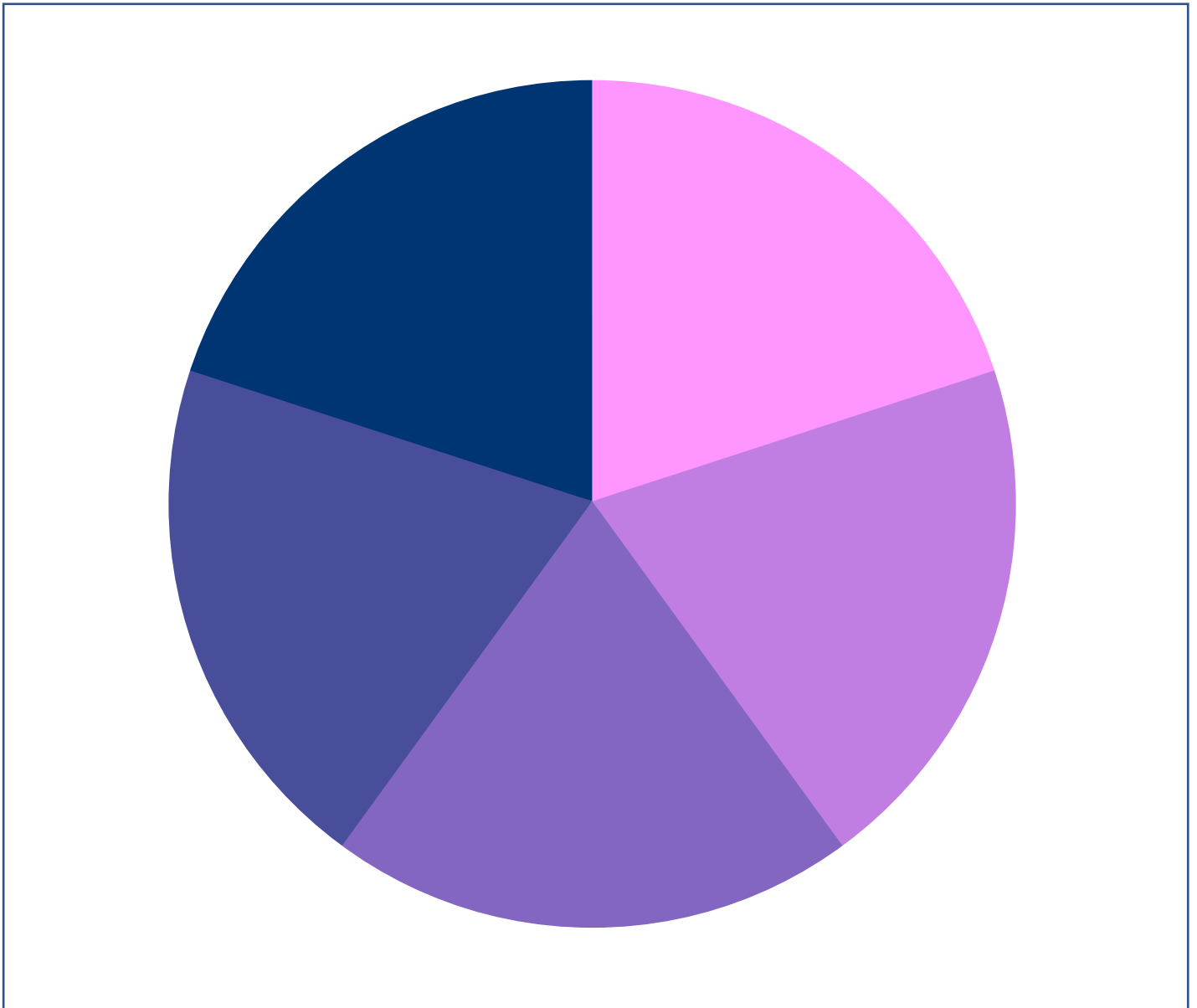
Each week, move the green wheel one space to the left so that it lines up with a different name. In this way, each person will be given a new chore each week, and chores will be shared equally between everyone.



Cut out the wheel below and write a different household chore in each box. Make sure that the chores you choose are as balanced as possible and take similar amounts of time to complete.



Cut out the box below. Write the names of your family members around the outer edge of the wheel – one person per section. If you don't have a white pen, just write on the white paper around the outside of the printed wheel.



You may wish to stick each circle on a piece of card to make your chore wheel stronger.

Attach your two circles through the centre points with a split pin.

Display your chore wheel in a prominent position in your home and use it to assign your family members a new chore each week by moving the wheel one place to the left.

I hope this helps you keep your home tidy with fewer family arguments.
